



## West of England Cocker Spaniel Club Seminar for Breed Beginners

West of England Cocker Spaniel Club will host a breed specific seminar in Cricklade Town Hall on the 7<sup>th</sup> November 2010 at 10am.

This seminar is aimed at beginners and is intended to assist newcomers to cocker spaniels to gain a better understanding of the breed. It will take the form of surgeries with live demonstrations to assist the beginners to understand how to trim cockers for show and how to interpret the breed standard.

One the day we will host breakout sessions with the intention of a more informal audience with breed experts and a maximum of 10 candidates per breed expert to assist interaction and discussion; candidates will move around the sessions in order to cover many aspects that are important in the interpretation of the cocker spaniel breed standard:

1. Show trimming hosted by breed expert Mike Masters which will take the morning.

A light Lunch will be provided to candidates.

2. The afternoon sessions will take the form of surgeries where candidates can break into smaller groups and attend sessions hosted by breed experts with the use of live models illustrating the standard and what to look for and how to intepret the breed standard.
